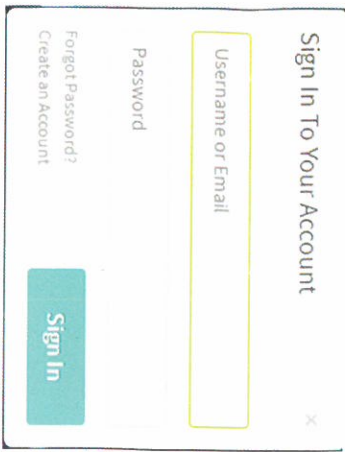


STEP 4 REMOTE MONITORING ON INTERNET



Note: Please read the tips when creating your account. You can change your hostname or add more laterly, or upgrade to No-IP Enhanced for more hostnames and less hassles.

2c. Once you have submitted your account information, it will send a confirmation email to the address you provided. The email contains a link you must click in order to confirm your account.
2d. Login to your account.

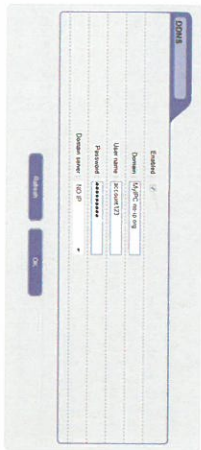


2e. Click "Add a Host", fill out the following fields to configure your host. After you are done, click "Add Host" to add your host.



2f. Enable DDNS on the IP Camera. Go to Configure—Network—>DDNS. Configure to enable DDNS function, input host domain, user name and password you created, choose NO IP as domain server, then click OK.

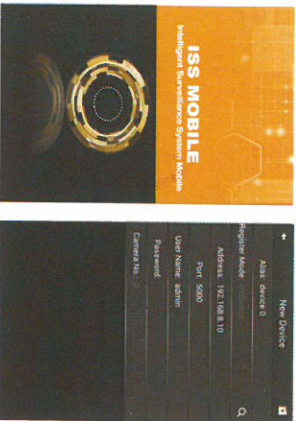

2g. Open IE and enter the host name (e.g. http://My/PC.no-ip.org) to access your IP Camera remotely.

▶ 3. Access IP Camera by mobile side (iPhone, iPad, Android phone).

- 3a. Install and run ISS MOBILE on your mobile phone.
- 3b. Add a device: Click [Device Icon] in the upper left corner, then select [Device Icon] to enter the Device Manager page, click [Add] to edit the new device's information, and then click [Save] to save.
- 3c. Live Play: Click [Live Play Icon] and select [Live Play Icon] to enter the LivePlay page, click [Channel Icon] to select channel(s) in the camera list, and then click "Start Live View" to view the video.
- 3d. Playback: Click [Playback Icon] and select [Playback Icon] to enter the Playback page, set the search conditions and click "Start Search", then slide the timeline bar to adjust the playback time;
- 3e. Log Search: Click [Log Search Icon] and select [Log Search Icon] to enter the Device Logs page, set the search conditions and click "Start Search" to show the log information;
- 3f. Configuration: Click [Configuration Icon] and select [Configuration Icon] to set password protection, view the help, configure software update, and check the software's version information and main features, etc.
